



Judith Samson PhD DSPP Student Scholarship Award

Dr. Judith Samson's legacy of distinguished service in psychology has been long recognized by colleagues, graduate students, and mental health advocates in the community. Since 1977, when Dr. Samson began her career in Dallas as a faculty member at UTSW's Psychology Division and psychologist at Dallas Child and Family Guidance Center, and later having a flourishing independent practice, she devoted herself to clinical work with children, adolescents, and adults and supervising the psychotherapy casework of UT Southwestern clinical psychology graduate students. A believer in professional organizations' shaping and supportive role in students' career development, she strongly encouraged trainees and early professionals to become active members in organizations such as DSPP and Dallas Psychological Association. Dr. Samson has always regarded personal psychoanalysis or psychotherapy as an essential part of a psychologist's professional development and unhesitatingly recommended that undertaking with graduate students and early career professionals. For her achievements in the field of psychology, Dr. Samson received Dallas Psychological Association's "Distinguished Psychologist" Award in 2012.

As a founding member of DSPP and President of the organization (1989-1990), Dr. Samson has contributed immeasurably to the organization she so loves with her wise leadership, her service on the Executive Council, and her scholarly presentations at our monthly programs and workshops. Known for her patronage of the Arts, she was instrumental in forming the DSPP's Arts Committee, including student members, and serving as its Chairman until 2003. Under her direction, the Arts Committee hosted a variety of programs, including film events, musical performances by local and out-of-town performers, art gallery exhibitions and artist talks, and evening events with authors. Those fortunate enough to serve with her as Arts Committee members were generously rewarded at planning meetings with extraordinary five-star meals, compliments of her second-to-none culinary skills. Now, in recognition of Dr. Samson's excellence in the field of psychology and her prudent leadership in our organization since its formation in 1982, and for her commitment to the professional development of students and young professionals, members of DSPP are pleased to establish the Student Scholarship Award in her honor.

Scholarship Information

The Dallas Society for Psychoanalytic Psychology will award a limited number of grants up to \$1,500 (student) or \$500 (early career) to attend a conference to which the individual has had accepted a psychoanalytically-oriented submission (poster, paper, presentation). This financial support is intended to help offset travel, lodging, transportation, meals, and incidental expenses. Selection for the grant will be based on past, current, and future intended DSPP involvement; financial need; and quality of contribution to the conference. We strongly encourage but do not require scholarship applicants to make use of the DSPP Scholars Program. Recipients will be selected by a small group of DSPP executive council members through a blind review process.

The submission deadline is: no less than **two months before the conference**. We will do our best to notify you of our decision within two weeks.
